The American Heart Association supports research broadly related to cardiovascular function and disease, stroke or to related clinical, basic science, bioengineering or biotechnology, and public health problems.

Some applicants, if eligible, may submit applications simultaneously to both Affiliate and National programs. See the affiliate program descriptions for details. Award activation is July 1, 2010.

Application Deadline: January 26, 2010

Pre-doctoral Fellowship

To help students initiate careers in cardiovascular and stroke research by providing research assistance and training.

1 to 2 years - maximum annual amount \$25,000

Beginning Grant-in-Aid

To promote the independent status of promising beginning scientists.

2 years project support - maximum annual amount of \$70,000

Postdoctoral Fellowship

To help a trainee initiate a career in cardiovascular and stroke research while obtaining significant research results.

2 years -maximum annual amount ranging from \$38,000-\$48,000

Grant-in-Aid

To encourage and adequately fund the most innovative and meritorious research projects from independent investigators.

2 year project and salary support - maximum annual amount of \$70,000

Special Funding

Special funding is available for research in ataxia cardiology, pediatric cardiomyopathy, pulmonary hypertension, resuscitation, geriatric cardiology and emergency medicine. These programs are brought to you in partnership with the AHA by the Pulmonary Hypertension Association, Friedreich's Ataxia Research Alliance, Emergency Medicine Association and Society for Academic Emergency Medicine, Philips, Society of Geriatric Cardiology, and the Children's Cardiomyopathy Foundation.
