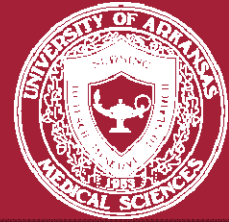


Dalme-Rickel Visiting Lectureship in Oncology/Community Health

“Surviving with Cancer”

Dr. Wickersham’s research focuses on adherence to tyrosine kinase inhibitors (TKIs) and management of side effects of TKIs to improve quality of life for individuals with advanced cancer who experience disparities in cancer care (e.g., race, age, rurality). Her research has included qualitative, quantitative, and translational research methods. The onset of the COVID-19 pandemic prompted a second line of inquiry, which is to examine the effect of COVID-19 on patients and health care providers.
