Adjunct faculty status must be approved every two years. If your application was approved in 2023, it is time to update!

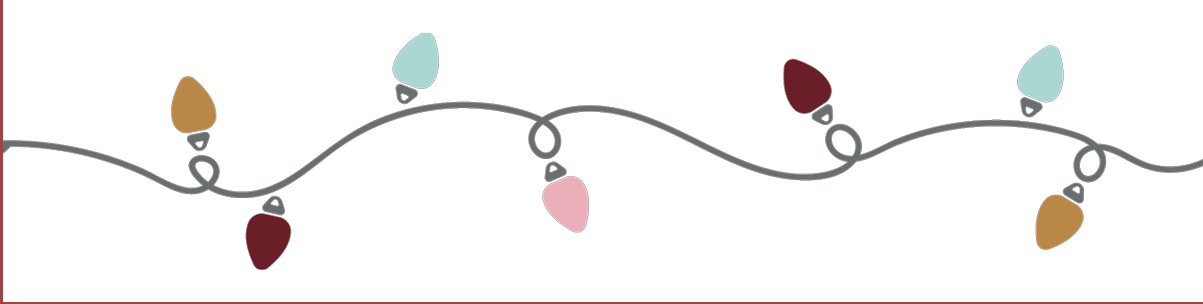
