- Spring: PMH Theory I: Diagnoses of Disorders
 - In conjunctions with Theory I: Psychopharmacology- Neuroanatomy, neurobiology, psychodynamics, etc.
 - **Practicum I: 180 hours with MD or APN**
 - May have up 2 preceptors
 - Focused on assessment, diagnosis, medication management
- Summer- PMH Nursing Theory II: Theories and therapy modalities (individual and family)
 - **Practicum II: 180 hours with therapist or counselor**
 - Focused on therapy- individual and group; NOT dx or medications
- Fall: PMH Theory III: Child/Adolescent and Older Adult
 - **Practicum III: 360 hours with MD or APN**; May have up 1-3 preceptors
 - 90 hours child/adolescent; 90 hours adult; 90 hours older adult (>55yo)
 - Focused on assessment, diagnosis, medication management
